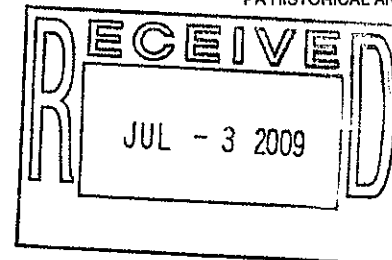

Dear President Spires:

I am contacting you on behalf of several constituents who have contacted me regarding contract negotiations for ACME Markets. I ask that they receive your full, fair, and prompt cooperation.

It has been described to me that four thousand men and women at ACME in Philadelphia and the suburbs have worked under a contract extension since February 2208 and that the United Food and Commercial Workers Local 1776 and your company have been in negotiations. On June 9, 2009, your company issued a final offer which was rejected by the workers on June 24, 2009. Additionally, it has been suggested that your company may exhaust an option to terminate the existing contract and implement a proposal unilaterally.

On behalf of the men and women who have contacted my office, I am asking you to support the ACME workers who are willing to stay on the job under their current contract while negotiations take place on a new contract. As a State Representative, my primary responsibility is protecting the safety and the rights of my constituents. Please consider their thoughts as you move forward in contract negotiations.
